Family Dollar Discussion

Many aspects of a proposed Family Dollar being developed in the former Save-A-Lot building was discussed with a formal proposal coming next month. Members of Empire Management Company were sent the Lima Vision Plan to help guide their proposal. Empire Management Company was made aware of some potential maintenance issues with the building, roof, loading dock and parking lot as well as potential upgrades to the facade and landscaping on the site.

Empire Management Company was notified of potential grants for both the facade and construction costs along with being informed of the next steps in the process and that a full board meeting will be needed to get approval.

This formal proposal will need to be reviewed by the historical preservation committee.

Pilato Tree Removal Business

Should there be a zoning issue, the Zoning board of appeals is the governing body and must rule on the issue.

Complaints of noncompliance should be sent to code enforcement. The planning board can hear these complaints but cannot rule on them.
